Morrisby Testing for Year 10 students

As part of our career's education programme, we offer students in Year 10 the opportunity to participate in Morrisby Psychometric Profiling. This is a tool used by many organisations to identify individual strengths and weaknesses and can help students to explore their career choices.

The Morrisby Profile test is offered to students at a cost of £30 and the test is to be taken at home by students using their own devices.

Participating students will take an online assessment taking approximately 100 minutes, although this can be broken down into several sessions. Students are not tested on knowledge but are asked questions about skill and subject preferences using a series of timed assessments. They should undertake the test in a quiet environment with no distractions. Once the assessment is complete, students will have access to personally tailored career and education suggestions, plus a wealth of careers-related resources.

Payment of £30 is made directly to Morrisby. Students are then able to take the test at any time from now until the end of the summer term. Morrisby will generate a code to allow students set up their Morrisby account. They do this by going onto the Morrisby website <https://www.morrisby.com> clicking onto the sign-up tab and following the instructions.
