English and Media Centre A Level Language Conference

The English department is excited to be able to offer the opportunity for all Year 13 A Level English Language students to attend above conference on Wednesday 19 November. The conference is an invaluable opportunity for students to gain further insights into ongoing language debates and linguistic research in areas that are covered by their A Level course. It is hoped that the students will be able to consolidate and develop their understanding of key sociolinguistic theories in preparation for their A Level examinations in May 2022. It will also allow students to experience what learning at higher education institutions will involve. The speakers and topics confirmed for the event are as follows:

- Professor Helen Sauntson (York, St Johns): Researching language, gender & sexuality
- Dr Tom Chatfield (author, tech philosopher and educator): Technology and language change
- Professor Jenny Cheshire (QMUL): The Story of MLE
- Dr George Bailey (University of York): Representing accent on social media
- Dr Robbie Love (Aston University): Tracking changes in swearing in spoken English

Students are asked to make their own way to the venue where they will be met by members of staff. We ask that all students ensure that they are at the venue to sign in with staff by 9.45am. Students will be dismissed from the conference when it finishes at 3.30pm when they will be able to make their own way home. The conference is being held at Friends House, 173-177 Euston Road, London, NW1 2BJ (directly opposite Euston Station). The event will last all day and students will need to bring a packed lunch with them, or purchase food prior to the start of the conference.

The cost of the conference is £28. Payment should be made electronically via <u>www.parentpay.com</u> by Tuesday 2 November.
