Transmission of Coronavirus from positive cases in the school community.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Any student or staff member who tests positive are advised to stay at home for 5 days.As always, any student or staff member who feels unwell should stay at home and rest.Close contacts should continue to attend school.Lunch Service will be staggered by Key Stage or Year Group but dining rooms will be open.Students reminded the importance of hand hygiene – Sanitiser is available at the entrance and exit to all buildings.	25.03.22
Transmission of Coronavirus in communal areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Assemblies will be delivered online and in person moving forward.Students, staff and visitors are welcome to continue wearing a mask in communal areas or classrooms if they wish to but the guidance no longer suggests this is necessary.	25.03.22
Lack of personal and hand hygiene leads to a spread of coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Continue Catch it bin it, kill it – tissues and bins in every classroomGood Hygiene posters are in all student and staff bathroomsSanitiser provided at every entrance and exit to buildings	25.03.22
Poor ventilation leading to risk of coronavirus spreading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Room vents, doors and windows will continue to be left open where possible.C02 Monitors are being rolled out to classrooms and offices where required and levels checked regularly.	25.03.22
