As mentioned in the presentation, we are able to support students requiring regular medication that can be self-administered. It must be in its original packaging with the information leaflet provided and the dosage detail enclosed. Students will need to hand this in on the departure day to Mrs Wehrle if they are on Trip 1 (4-6 July) or Mrs Northcote if they are on Trip 2 (6-8 July).

A reminder for students to complete the Microsoft Form that Mr Morgan sent out via email to students regarding choice of an accommodation buddy. This needs to be completed by the end of the week. We cannot guarantee preferences made after this time.
