The A Level History course at Weald of Kent Grammar School has been designed to ensure that you develop your knowledge of British, European and World History. This will support you in becoming a well-rounded and accomplished historian.

We follow the AQA specification. This involves two units and a non-examined unit. The NEA consists of a 100 Year study. Currently this is on Tsarism in Russia between 1825 and 1917.
