Item of Clothing	Can Wear	Cannot Wear
Suit Jackets/Blazers	<p>A suit jacket/blazer can be worn over a blouse/shirt/thin jumper</p> <p>Waistcoats may be worn over a blouse/shirt</p> <p>A suit jacket/blazer must be worn for formal events</p>	<p>Coat instead of suit jacket</p> <p>Denim, fur or leather jackets</p>
Skirt/Dress/Trousers	<p>Must be no shorter than mid-thigh</p> <p>Dresses must be smart/tailored</p> <p>Trousers must be smart/tailored</p>	<p>Very short skirts or dresses</p> <p>Low cut or revealing dresses</p> <p>Strappy dresses</p> <p>Casual trousers including jeans, leggings, tracksuit bottoms, cargo trousers</p>
Shirts/Blouses/Tops	Office appropriate top	<p>Casual tops T-shirts</p> <p>Sheer material</p> <p>Strappy tops</p> <p>Low cut or revealing tops</p>
Jumpers/Cardigans	<p>Smart jumpers or cardigans</p> <p>Sweatshirts with discreet logos</p>	<p>Jumpers with large logos</p> <p>Hoodies</p> <p>Oversized/casual jumpers and cardigans</p>
Shoes	<p>Any smart office type shoes</p> <p>Smart boots</p> <p>Smart trainers</p> <p>Smart sandals</p>	<p>Heels higher than 6cm, platform shoes or boots, UGG boots, casual trainers, crocs, plimsolls, flip flops, casual sandals</p>

Coats	Appropriate coat for outside use only	Leather, denim, fur coats Coats inside
Makeup and Hair	Office appropriate and smart Natural hair colours only	
Student ID Lanyard	To be worn at all times - students will be charged £3 for replacement lanyards and cards if lost	Lanyard without ID card inserted
