



## Examination Results 2018

### GCSE Results 2018

This was the first year that the new reformed '9-1' GCSE courses were examined in most subjects, and the second year of reformed GCSEs for English Language, English Literature and Mathematics. These subjects were graded 9-1. Some subjects have yet to be reformed and continue to be graded A\*-G. This does make year-on-year comparisons impossible for many subjects. As a guide, the new Grade 7 is equal to the Grade A, whilst the new Grade 4 is equal to a Grade C.

We are delighted with the GCSE results in 2018. The students achieved the best average grade of any Weald cohort since this measure was introduced in 2014 with the greatest proportion of students averaging a Grade 7 and above.

- ✓ The number of students in Year 11 was 169.
- ✓ The average grade was 7.1.
- ✓ 59% of all grades were Grades 7-9 and 56% were Grades A\*-A.
- ✓ 99% of students achieved a Grade 4 or higher in English and in Mathematics.
- ✓ 69 students (41% of the year) averaged at 7.0 (Grade A) or higher.
- ✓ The school's Progress 8 score is +1.01. This means that on average across the year group an extra grade of added value is achieved by each student in each subject, compared to students in other schools with similar attainment scores at the end of Year 6.
- ✓ Weald of Kent achieved the highest progress score of any of the six grammar schools in West Kent in 2018.

### A Level Results 2018

We were equally delighted with the Year 13 results at A level. This was our largest ever cohort to go through the Sixth Form, with 169 students. The average point score was the highest in three years and the proportion of A\* and A grades the highest since 2012.

- ✓ The average grade as a Grade B.
- ✓ The average point score was 40.6
- ✓ 38.2% of all grades were A\* and A
- ✓ 34 students achieved AAA or better and ten students achieved A\*A\* or better
- ✓ 72.5% of all grades were A\*, A or B

The school did not enter any candidates for the reformed AS examinations.
