## Public Examination Results 2023

## GCSE Results

We are delighted with the Year 11 GCSE results and very proud of our students for their well-deserved achievements.

292 students were entered for the examinations and achieved as follows:

- Progress 8 score was $\mathbf{+ 0 . 8 3}$ putting us in the top $\mathbf{2 . 5 \%}$ of all schools nationally
- Attainment 8 score was 70.4
- $61.8 \%$ of grades were 9-7
- 435 of all grades were 9 (16\%)
- $95.2 \%$ of students achieved a 9-5 grade in English and Maths
- $55 \%$ of students were entered for the English Baccalaureate (EBacc)
- EBacc average point score was 6.41

We are yet again very proud of our Year 13 A-level results.
215 students were entered for the examinations and achieved as follows:

- $65.3 \%$ of all grades were A*-B $^{*}$
- $12.7 \%$ of all grades were $A^{*}$
- $34.4 \%$ of all grades were $A^{*}$-A
- 8 students achieved 3 or more A* grades
- 42 students achieved straight A*/ A grades
- $51.3 \%$ of EPQ grades are A*
- The average grade was a B
- $99 \%$ of students completed their study programme
