University of Sussex online Summer School

University of Sussex are offering a free four-day Online Summer School for Year 12 students who are curious about university life and want to build confidence for their next steps.

Running from Tuesday 30 June to Friday 3 July 2026, the programme gives students the chance to:

- explore a university subject they are interested in
- experience university-level tasters
- complete a short academic project to support a future personal statement
- receive expert guidance on applying to university and career pathways

Students can choose from a wide range of subject areas, including Law, Psychology, Engineering, Business, Politics, Arts and Social Sciences.

The summer school is delivered online by University of Sussex academics, professional staff and student ambassadors, with opportunities to meet peers and ask questions about university life.
