# Music tuition at Weald Information and application form



Music tuition at Weald of Kent Grammar School is provided by a team of highly qualified and experienced teachers. If you would like music lessons for your child, please apply using the application form on the following page.

You will be sent confirmation either that tuition is available, once a teacher has been allocated, or to confirm that the student's name is on the waiting list.

Individual lessons last 30 minutes and are rotated so students do not miss the same lesson twice across a five-to-six week period. Break and lunchtime clashes are also avoided.

Lessons are paid for termly and will be invoiced by the individual teachers at the start of each term. Payment is to be made directly to the music teacher.

New students are expected to complete at least one full term of 10 lessons before considering withdrawal. If you wish to discontinue lessons, written notice must be submitted to the teacher and to the Head of Music before the following dates:

23 October 2020	for lessons to cease in December 2020
12 February 2021	to cease at the Easter break
28 May 2021	to cease in July 2021.

If adequate notice is not given (i.e. before the above dates) a further course of 10 lessons will by payable, whether or not the student attends.
