Kent County Council are constructing a Grammar annexe extension to the existing Weald of Kent Grammar annexe for Tunbridge Wells Grammar School for Boys, including the fit out of the shell & core area and refurbishment works to Weald of Kent designed by Bond Bryan Architects.

The facilities inside of the new extension include multi-use classrooms, IT suites, kitchen and dining facilities, science laboratories, as well as external works

Willmott Dixon has been appointed main contractor to deliver the third phase of this exciting development that first started back in 2014

What will we be doing on site?

Willmott Dixon commenced on site on Wednesday 18th November with our 'soft start' of delivery of temporary welfare cabins and setting the site up.

The main works commenced on Monday 23rd November with the 8 weeks groundworks to the new build extension and removal of existing materials / cladding / curtain walling to the shell and core area.
