Music Lessons

The music department is delighted to announce that face to face private music lessons will return after the Easter holidays, week beginning 19 April.

In accordance with Government guidelines and the school's risk assessment policy, teachers will be required to participate in the lateral flow testing programme and will be provided with cleaning products to ensure a clean and safe environment for all students. All teachers will be allocated an additional 5 minutes in between lessons to carry out the cleaning. Other safety requirements specific to instruments and singing will be guided by the teacher. In addition, lessons will also return to a rotation system, so no student will miss the same lesson twice.
